Google Tag Manager

What Information We Collect

We do not collect your personal info. We track non-personal info - trek device information, browser information, your interaction with the Services such as visited pages, source of visit, etc. You can not be identified with provided info. Also, your information, whether public or private, will not be sold or exchanged. If you choose to subscribe for marketing emailing campaigns, the email address you provide for registering may be used to send you information about recent updates, occasional company news, related product or service information, etc. However, at any moment, you may restrict access to it and forbid us to use it for marketing purposes.
